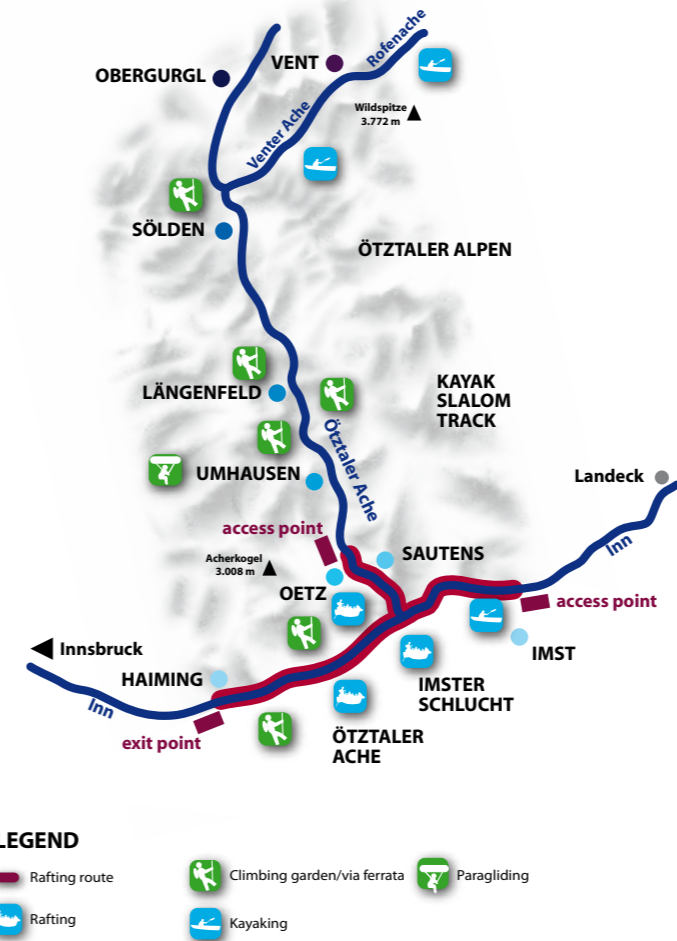

A rafting tour to the Imster Schlucht gorge, one of Europe's most frequented rafting areas, ranks among the sports highlights in the Ötztal. Appropriate equipment ensures a memorable experience on a 14 km route between Imst and Haiming. A short introductory information on safety measures is followed by a 2.5-hour tour full of fun and action, guided by a certified boat guide.

Kayak & Canoe Sports

The Ötztal valley and its glacier brooks offer really unique white water pleasures between May and October. The most renowned access points can be found on the rivers Rofen Ache, Venter Ache and Ötztal Ache. There is something for all levels and abilities: adventures amid gorges and brooks or a bit easier routes with small waves in vicinity to the river shore await all kayak fans. A permanent 350-meter canoe track with 42 flexible gates and a small start house with Internet access was installed in Oetz. Canoeists and canoe clubs can use it free of charge for training purposes and races from early May to late October.
