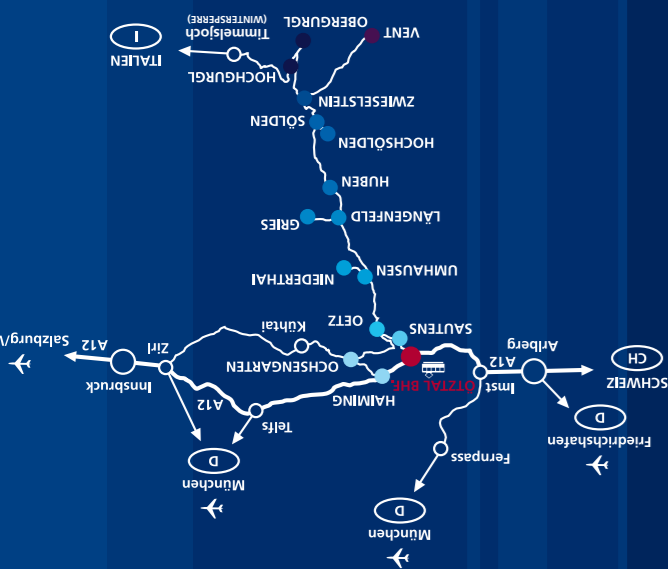

## Cross-Country Skiing

### PILL / ANGERN / POSCHACH HIGH ALTITUDE TRAIL

Length: 7 km, skating & classic style  
 Degree of difficulty: intermediate  
 Access at the base terminal of Hochgurgl gondola. Level route along the valley bottom of Pill/Angern – easy to intermediate ascent via the meadows of Isse to the hamlets of Königsrain and Alt-Poschach – along the right shore of the Ötztaler Ache river back to the car park past Hotel Jagdhof.

### PRACTICING TRACK IN THE CENTER OF OBERGURGL

Length: 3 km, skating & classic style  
 Degree of difficulty: easy  
 Access at Bobo's Kids Club or below the church, Schalfkoglweg. Two level cross-country skiing loops connected to the track along the Ötztaler Ache in the direction of Bobo's Playground – across the brook – back via Bartebene area.

### HOCHGURGL PRACTICING TRACK

Length: 2 km, skating & classic style  
 Degree of difficulty: easy  
 Access above the chapel in Hochgurgl, next to the ski run. Level loop trail across picture-book landscapes towards the timberline, in the direction of Königstal valley. A part of the track is equipped with floodlights and features a separate winter walking path.

### NORDIC SKIING INSTRUCTION

Cross-country skiing instruction for young and old available at the Obergurgl-Hochgurgl Ski Schools.

## Winter Hiking

### HOCHGURGL ROMANTIC ROUTE (PARTLY FLOODLIT)

Scenic trail along the Hochgurgl Practicing Track -> leading across picture-book landscapes towards the timberline and Königstal valley. Partly equipped with floodlights.  
 Time: 0.5 hr

### ZIRBENWALD NATURE TRAIL

From Obergurgl to the University Center -> keep to the right towards David's Hütte -> and the fork-off to Zirbenwald stone pine trail. Return to Obergurgl across Zirbenwald bridge, following Imfong trail on the left.  
 Time: 1 hr

### GURGLERTAL WINTER HIKING TRAIL

Access at the base terminal of Hochgurgl gondola -> level route along the valley bottom of Pill/Angern -> easy to intermediate ascent via the meadows of Isse to the hamlets of Königsrain and Alt-Poschach -> along the right shore of the Ötztaler Ache river back to the car park past Hotel Jagdhof.  
 Time: 1 hr

### WINTER HIKING ROUTE TO SCHÖNWIESHÜTTE

From Obergurgl to Davids Hütte -> up to Schönwieshütte, Schönwieshütte is extremely quiet and secluded at the entrance to Rotmoostal valley. Open 5 days a week from mid February. Closed on Saturday and Sunday.  
 Time: 1.5 hrs

### TOP MOUNTAIN STAR (3080 M)

Towering at 3080 m above sea level, the Top Mountain Star seems to touch the sky. A unique viewing platform with Panorama Bar. The new "Peak House" offers uninterrupted views of the Ötztal Alps and the Italian Dolomites.

### HOHE MUT ALM (2670 M)

Hohe Mut ranks among the most scenic vantage points in Tirol, offering views of 21 peaks beyond 3000 meters. A ride in the new Gaisberg and Hohe Mut mountain gondola creates memories that will stay with you forever, breathtaking 360-degree views included.

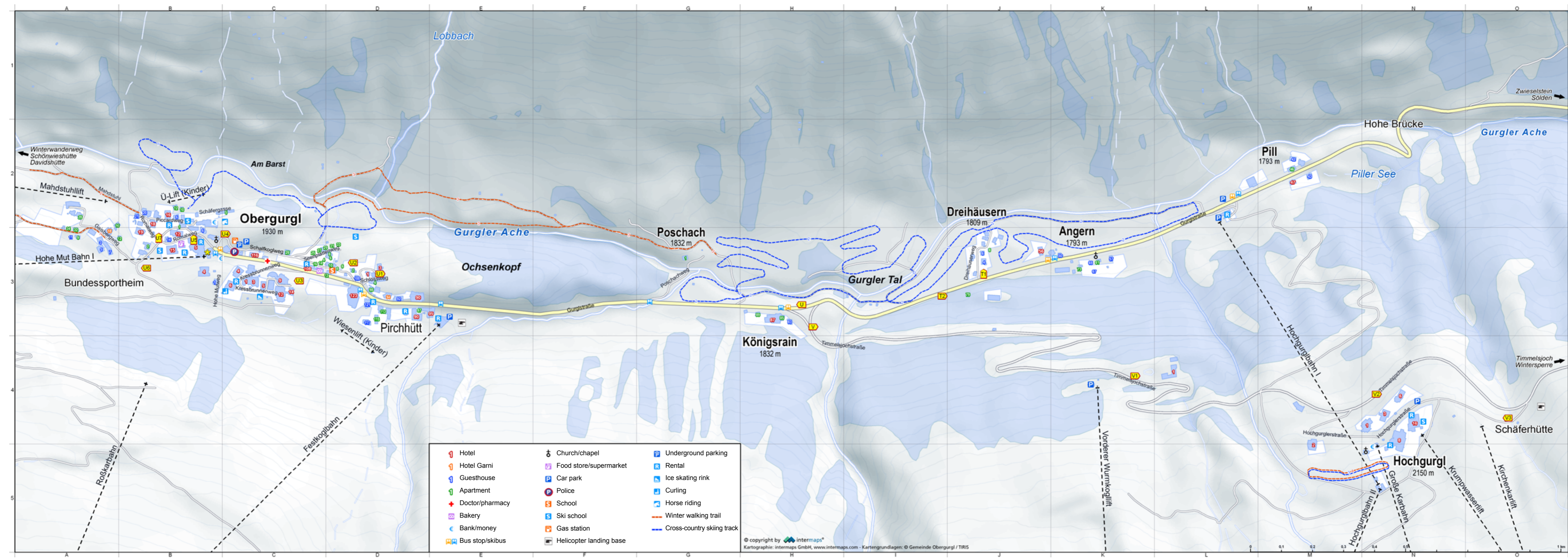
